What's exciting in your new office?

What operation do you perform most often?

Rhinoplasty (cosmetic nasal reshaping). Patients travel from all over the World to seek out my culturally sensitive approach. I use Vectra 3-D to ensure that my patients and I are on the same page before any incisions are made.
